Penn Clinical Scholars will become highly capable health services researchers, both able to develop research that is highly relevant to the broader community and to translate research findings into action.

The Penn CSP Training Experience

The Clinical Scholars Program (CSP) at Penn will offer Scholars a two-three year, masters-level interdisciplinary research training, underpinned by strong mentoring and a longitudinal community-based research experience. The primary areas of the masters training program will be:

- Research skills
- Health policy
- Health-related social sciences
- Professional development

The CSP at Penn includes a competitive stipend and educational costs.

The Community Experience

To develop skills necessary to translate research into action and effective policy, the Penn Clinical Scholar will engage in longitudinal relationships with one or more of Penn's community-based partner organizations.
